The 2010 summer ozone season in the Bay Area officially starts on Monday, May 3.

During the summer months when ground-level ozone, or "smog," becomes a pollution problem, the Bay Area Air District issues *Spare the Air Smog Alerts* on days when air quality is forecast to be unhealthy.
