**Some Hiking & Fishing Areas Closed But South Side of Los Vaqueros Watershed Remains Open for Fishing, Hiking**

Preparing to Move Marina, Expand 'Rock Wall'

The Contra Costa Water District has closed the North side of the Los Vaqueros Watershed near Brentwood for the expansion of the Los Vaqueros Reservoir, and now some portions of the South side are now closed, though the Marina remains open with [boat rentals, fishing and limited hiking.](#)

The reservoir's capacity is being expanded from its current 100,000 acre-feet to 160,000. We have new photos of construction & [a video on how we're protecting animals.](#)

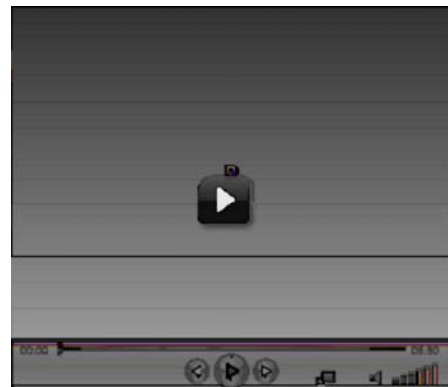
