Radiation Detected In US Milk Supply, Officials Say

SAN DIEGO -- While trace amounts of radiation have recently been detected in the nation's milk supply, health experts say it's minimal and perfectly safe to drink.

Radiation has been detected in 20 states and radioactive iodine has now been detected in milk from dairies in San Luis Obispo and in Washington state.

Dr. Don Milton from the University of Maryland said, "From the time the cow produces the milk and the farmer collects the milk, until it gets to your table, it is not very long. It is a matter of a few days."



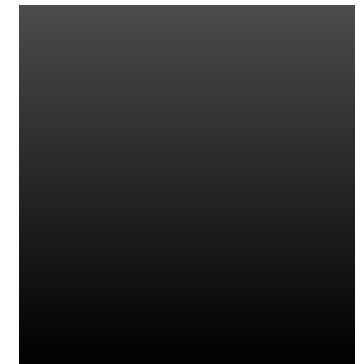

Dr. Hailu Kinde at the University of California, Davis told ABC News, "I would be mor about milk which is not handled properly and gets spoiled."

Clay Detlefsen with the International Dairy Foods Association in Washington, D.C., tol this really isn't about the milk.

"It's just that the government has decided that milk is a good representation of what's ha the larger food supply and it's a convenient way for the government to get good data," s; Detlefsen.

Detlefsen also said in the coming weeks "we're going to hear more and more about a lot other products, but milk is kind of sexy in some ways and it's a ubiquitous, important pr getting a lot of attention."

Local pharmacists told 10News the demand for potassium iodide pills here in San Dieg dropped significantly since the threat of radiation from Japan first hit the news.
