25x'25

The 25x'25 Alliance is a powerful coalition united behind the goal of securing 25 percent of the nation's energy needs from renewable sources by the year 2025. They intend to do this by mobilizing the agricultural and forestry communities to work proactively in support of climate change solutions.

350.org

350.org is an international campaign dedicated to building a movement to unite the world around solutions to the climate crisis. Their focus is on the number 350 – as in parts CO₂ per million, the level scientists have identified as the safe upper limit for CO₂ in our atmosphere.

Blue Green Alliance

The Blue Green Alliance is a national, strategic partnership between labor unions and environmental organizations dedicated to expanding the number and quality of jobs in the green economy. Blue Green represents more than 6,000,000 people in search of good jobs, a clean environment and a green economy. They work on issues ranging from energy and climate change to transportation to workers' rights and green chemistry.

Earth Day Network

Earth Day Network was founded on the premise that all people, regardless of race, gender, income, or geography, have a moral right to a healthy, sustainable environment. They pursue their mission through a combination of education, public policy, and consumer activism campaigns.

Energy Action Coalition

Energy Action Coalition is a coalition of youth climate leaders that unites a diversity of organizations in an alliance that supports and strengthens the student and youth clean and just energy movement in North America. EAC works to leverage their collective power and create change for a clean, efficient, just and renewable energy future.

Environmental Justice and Climate Change Initiative

The EJCC is a diverse coalition of U.S. environmental justice, religious, climate justice, policy and advocacy networks working for climate justice. This coalition develops projects, programs and papers to educate policymakers and people in communities across the country about the effects of climate change and environmental injustice.

The Evangelical Environmental Network (EEN) is a non-profit organization that seeks to educate, inspire, and mobilize Christians in their effort to care for God's creation, to be faithful stewards of God's provision, and to advocate for actions and policies that honor God and protect the environment.
