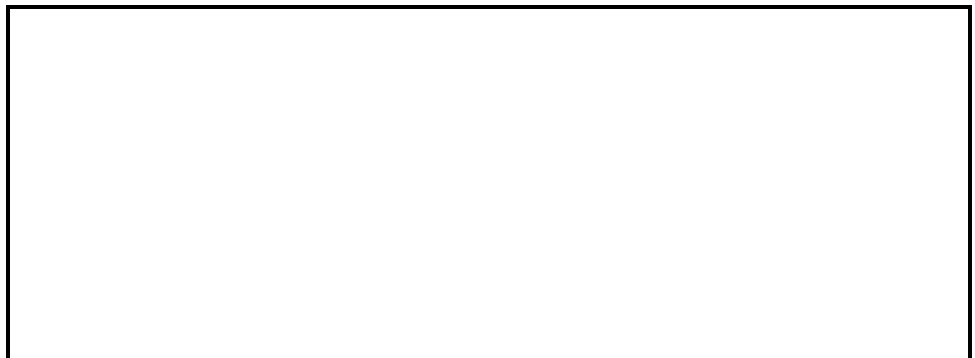

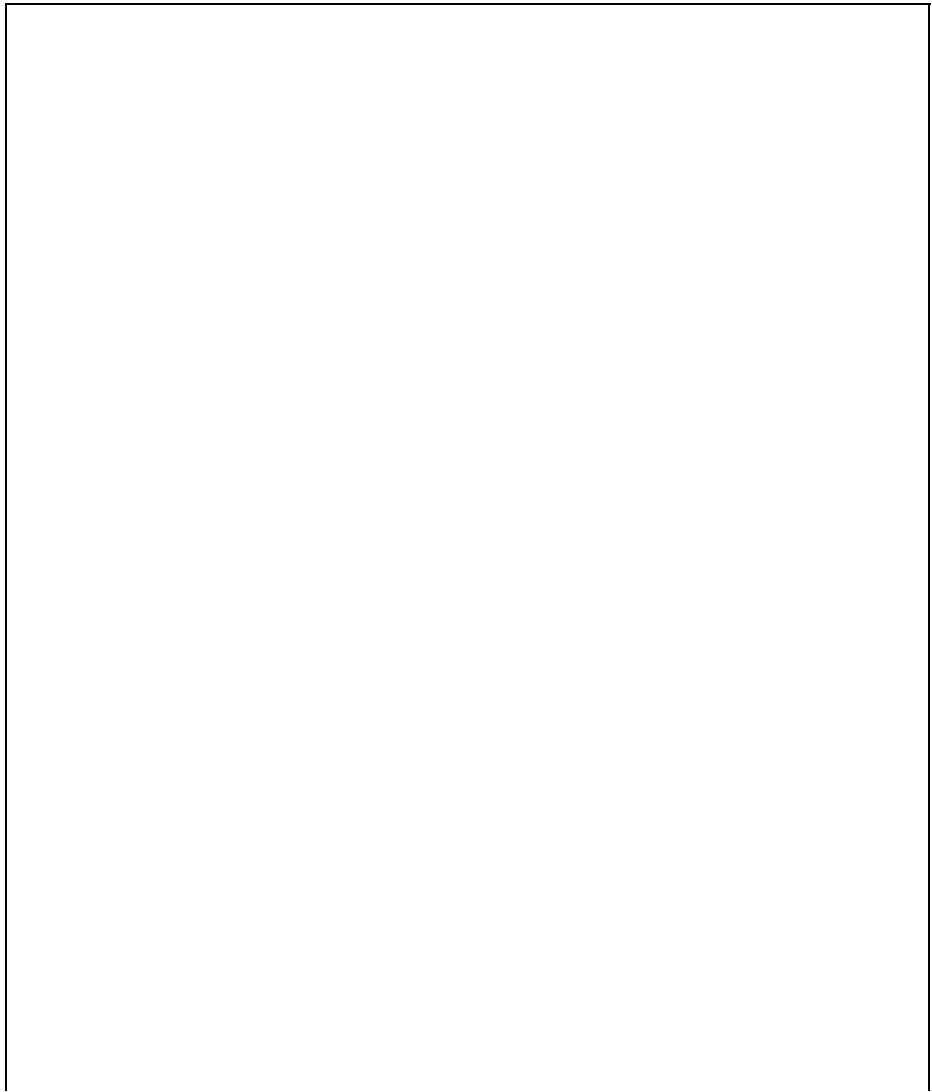


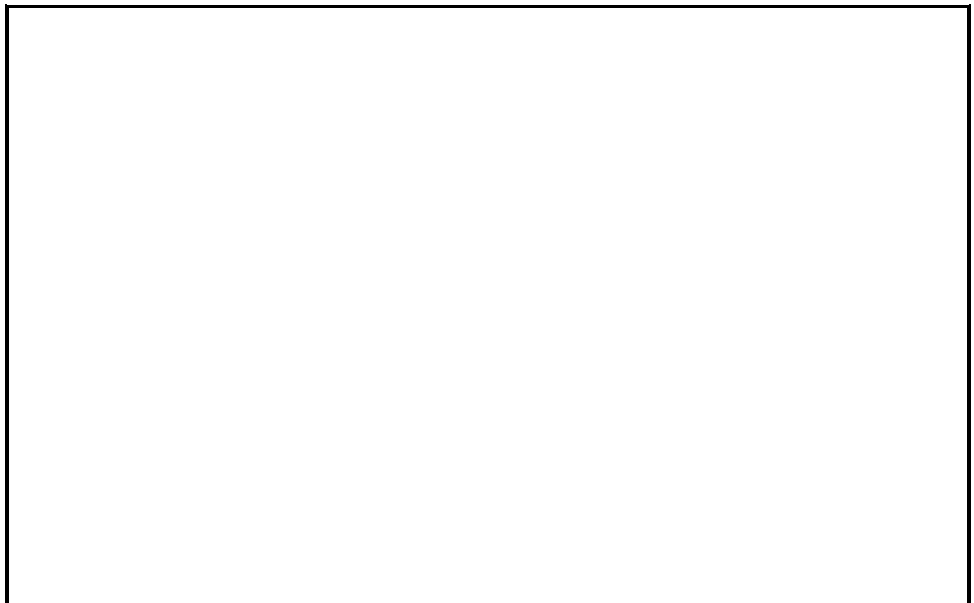
A 747 hard at work.
